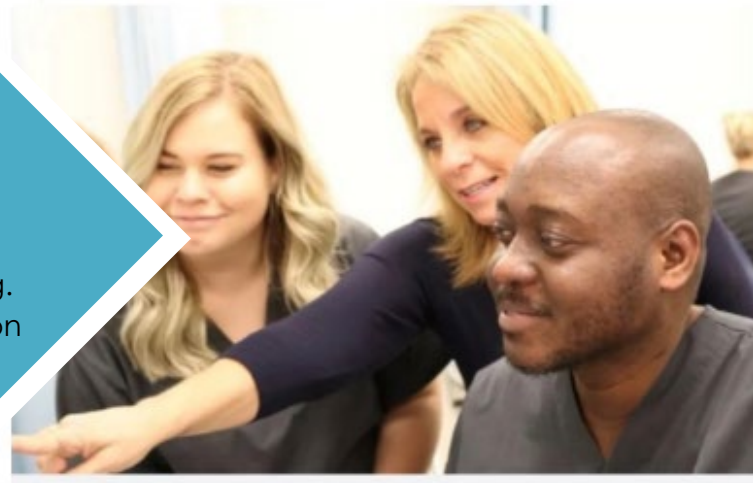





DMS APPLICATION

Deadline		DEADLINES AND DUE DATES
<input type="checkbox"/>	Upon College Acceptance	Schedule an appointment to meet with your advisor to discuss your goals. Your advisor will assist you with scheduling your classes.
<input type="checkbox"/>	During Advising Appointment	Review Entrance Criteria – Students MUST complete all 7 core classes listed on the admission score sheet prior to program application.
<input type="checkbox"/>	April 1 st	12 hours of DMS lab observation is required. Please schedule hours by April 1 st . Deadline to observe is April 30 th . Hours are scheduled with DMS Program Clinical Coordinator.
<input type="checkbox"/>	May 1 st	32 hours of observation at 3 clinical sites must be completed and submitted by May 1 st . DMS Lab observation counts as 1 clinical site and 12 hours of observation. Completion of DMS 1001 and DMS 1010 with grade of C or higher, 8 hours of observation is awarded for each completed class.
<input type="checkbox"/>	May 31 st	Complete USA Assessment Test by May 31 st . The cost is \$65.00. Pay the fee at the Business Office located in Bryson Hall (BR). Schedule with testing center 740-389-4636 ext. 1193
<input type="checkbox"/>	June 1 st	Deadline for DMS Application is June 1 st . After completion of Spring Semester, Schedule an application appointment with Program Director.
<input type="checkbox"/>	June 1 st	Submit 3 page APA format Admission Essay (not including cover or reference page) during your application appointment with Program Director.
<input type="checkbox"/>	After June 1 st	Subjective Interview Process. The Program Director will call you to schedule this appointment.
<input type="checkbox"/>		Notification of Acceptance. Applicants will be notified by mail within 2 weeks of interview.
